EOG Resources, Inc (OGRID No 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Hearns 34 State Com No. 704H Well** to be completed within the WC-025 G-09 S2433361, Upper Wolfcamp (Pool Code 98092) underlying Sections 27 and 34, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, N M P M , Lea County, New Mexico This well will be drilled from a surface location 300 feet from the South line and 1,386 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 34 The upper most perforation will be located 330 feet from South line and 1,289 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 34 and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the North line and 1,289 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 27 Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than 330 feet to the eastern, southeastern, and northeastern boundaries of the project area

EOG is the 100 percent working interest owner in the E/2 W/2 of Section 34 EOG is the operator of two wells developing the E/2 W/2 of Section 34 the Hearns 27 State Com No 501H Well and the Hearns 27 State Com No 301H Well

EOG has permitted the Frazier 703H Well, which will develop the spacing unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 27 The E/2 W/2 of Section 27 has one additional owner besides EOG That owner is also a working interest owner in the subject well That interest owner has been provided notice of EOG's request for an unorthodox location Approval of the unorthodox completed

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interval will allow EOG to use their preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area and thereby prevent waste

Exhibit A is a draft Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Hearns 34 State Com No. 704H** encroaches on the spacing and proration units to the East, Northeast, and Southeast

Exhibit B is a land plat for Sections 27 and 34 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed **Hearns 34 State Com No. 704H** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells

Exhibit C is a list of the parties affected by the encroachment to the Northeast and East. As described above, EOG owns 100 percent of the interest in the E/2 W/2 of Section 34. There are no affected parties in the spacing units to the Southeast of the proposed well or in the W/2 E/2 of Section 34. Each of the parties listed on Exhibit C have been provided notice of this application by certified mail. A copy of this application has been provided to the New Mexico State Land Office.




