Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*  
A 1/2" ball valve broke off at the threads to a Weldolet on our Ramsey N Residue Pipeline. Natural gas leak was spotted at 0913, 5/26/17 and the gas leaked until line was shut in 45 mins. later. We calculated a gas release of 2.475 MMSCF, due to vibration. Affected spool piece was removed, repairs made, and line put back in service the same day.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
The gas was not recovered. We are currently rechecking all torque on pipeline at custody transfer station, tightening U-bolts over pipe, and installing a thrust block at receiver to reduce vibration on pipeline.
