Dear Mr. Johnson,

Allstate Environmental Services has been contracted by Yates Petroleum to conduct cleanup/remediation work at the subject tank battery. On February 3, 2005 Yates experienced a spill of 15 bbls. of oil and 10 bbls. of water. Part of the spill ran out of the containment berm and onto the right-of-way of State Highway 176 for a length of about 400 ft. The plan is to excavate all of the contaminated soil onto dump trucks and haul the soil to an approved disposal site and backfill with clean native soil.

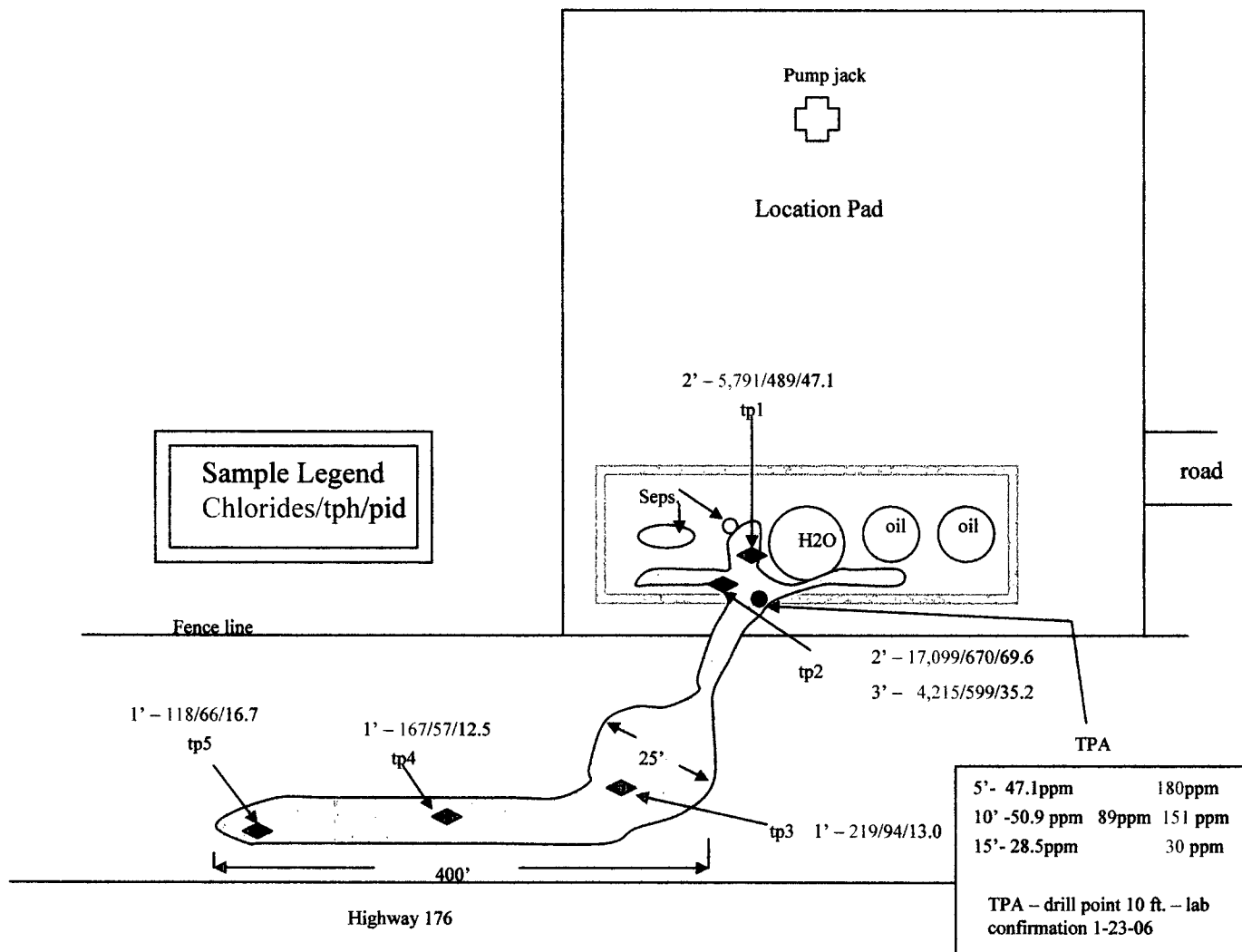
