Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The SWD facility received a slug of oil from one of the batteries and over flowed the oil tank into the line SPCC containment ring. The lease operator opened the equalizer valve to the tanks and equalized the fluid level and dispatched a vacuum truck to remove fluids from the lined containment. Approximately 39 bbls of oil was released and approximately 39 bbls oil was recovered.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Approximately 39 BBLs of oil were released from oil tank into the lined SPCC containment ring. A vacuum truck was dispatched and recovered approximately 39 bbls oil from the lined containment. Once fluids were removed the liner was visually inspected by Devon field staff for any pinholes or punctures and none were found. Based on this inspection there is no evidence that the spill fluids left containment.

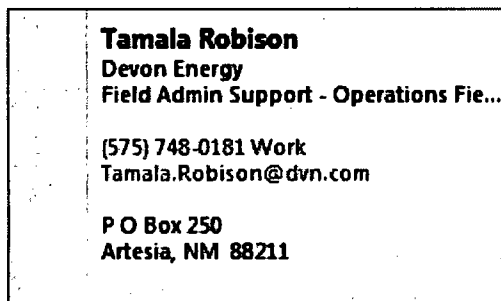
