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Reference is made to your letter of January 29, 1963, wherein you request authority to complete your Jicarille spache "B" dell No. 10 located in the N2/4 ou/4 of Section 20, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, WEM, Rio Arribe County, New N xico, with 33inch 10 casing and produce the Iskota hydrocarbons through said casing string as a tubingless completion. We have also received the gasliquid ratio report requested in our letter of February 6, 1963.
