Reference is made to your request of April 8, 1986 to increase the surface injection pressure on your Artesia Plant SWD No. 1 Well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on April 3, 1986. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase your surface injection pressure on the following well(s):

Artesia Plant SWD No. 1 Section 7, T-18S, R-28E Eddy County, New Mexico	810 PSIG

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or it is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
