Reference is made to your request dated June 1, 1992, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Shinnery "14" Federal Well No. 5. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on May 15, 1992. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on the well is justified at this time.


