Due to inadvertence Division Administrative Order NSP-1898 (NSL) issued on Division administrative application reference No. pTDS0-611735069 and dated May 30, 2006 does not correctly state the intended of the Division.


The fifth, or last, paragraph on page 2 of Division Administrative Order NSP-1898 (NSL), be and the same, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

*"By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rules 104.D (2) (b) and 104.F (2), the above-described non-standard 80-acre lay-down oil spacing and proration unit in the Hightower-Devonian Pool and unorthodox Devonian oil well location for Murchison's proposed Hightower State Unit Well No. 1 (API No. 30-025-37901) is hereby approved."*

The corrections set forth in this order, which is hereby entered into the Division's administrative database as administrative application reference No. pMES0-615235433, shall be entered retroactively as of May 30, 2006; all other provisions of Division Administrative Order NSP-1898 (NSL) shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
