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

CLEAN UP PLAN

- (1) ALL OF THE FLUIDS WERE REMOVED FROM THE DIKE AREA WITH A VACUUM TRUCK AND DISPOSED OF PROPERLY.
- (2) ROADRUNNER ENVIRONMENTAL DUG UP 72 YARDS OF SOIL AND HAULED IT TO CONTROLLED RECOVERY INC.
- (3) B AND R TRUCKING USED A TRACKHOE AND FIVE BELLYDUMPS TO HAUL NINETTEN LOADS OF SOIL TO CONTROLLED RECOVERY INC. EACH LOAD WAS ROUGHLY TWENTY YARDS WHICH TOTALLED 380 YARDS.
- (4) ALL OF THE EQUIPMENT WAS MOVED TO THE NORTH SIDE OF THE PIT. IT WAS BLM APPROVED. THE GROUND WAS LEVELLED AND A SIX INCH SANDPAD WAS LAID DOWN BEFORE THE PLASTIC LINER WAS INSTALLED. AFTER THE PLASTIC WAS LAID DOWN ANOTHER SIX INCH SANDPAD WAS LAID ON TOP ON TOP OF IT. THE PLASTIC LINER COVERS ALL BACKS. THE 300 BARRELL WATER TANK PLUS AND ADDITIONAL 300 BARRELL WATERTANK WAS SAT ON THE PAD. THE EXTRA TANK WAS INSTALLED TO KEEP THE DISPOSAL FROM RUNNING OVER.
- (5) THE DUG OUT PIT AREA WILL BE FILLED WITH SOIL FROM THE LOCATION ON WHICH IT SITS.
