Aztec State Well No. 7
Lea County, New Mexico***

Dear Ms. Hunt:

Reference is made to your request received by the Division on July 24, 2006, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Aztec State Well No. 7, which is currently within the Northeast Maljamar Waterflood Project. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on June 29, 2006. The results of the step rate test show that an increase in the surface injection pressure for this well is justified and will not result in the fracturing of the injection formation and confining strata.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected fluid is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.


