Reference is made to the following: (i) your application on behalf of the operator, Apache Corporation, filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe, New Mexico on July 6, 2006 (*administrative application reference No. pTDS0-618734647*); and (ii) the Division's records in Santa Fe: all concerning Apache Corporation's request for a non-standard 160-acre gas spacing unit comprising the following acreage in the Undesignated Jalmat Gas Pool (79240):

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM

Section 16: NW/4.


This application has been duly filed under the provisions of the "*Special Pool Rules for the Jalmat Gas Pool,*" as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170-P, issued in Case No. 12563 on December 14, 2001.

It is the Division's understanding this proposed unit is to be dedicated to Apache Corporation's existing New Mexico "BZ" State (NCT-8) Well No. 2 (**API No. 30-025-10747**), located at a standard Jalmat gas well location 1980 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of Section 16.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rules 4 (C) (1) (a) and 4 (D) of the special rules governing the Jalmat Gas Pool, the above-described 160-acre non-standard gas spacing unit is hereby approved.

Jurisdiction of this matter shall be further retained for the entry of any such subsequent orders, as the Division may deem necessary.
