Re: Application of Roca Operating, Inc., for administrative approval of the simultaneous dedication of the N/2 NE/4 of Section 36, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico to its New Mexico 36 State Well No. 1 and its New Mexico 36 State Well No. 2.

Dear Mr. Fesmire:

Roca Operating, Inc. ("Roca") is the operator of a standard 80-acre spacing unit in the E.K.-Bone Springs Pool comprised of the N/2 NE/4 of Section 36, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This spacing unit is dedicated to Roca's New Mexico 36 State Well No. 2 which produces from the Second Bones Springs Sand in the EK Bone Springs Field.

Roca seeks administrative approval of the simultaneous dedication of this standard 80-acre spacing unit to the following two wells:

- A. the New Mexico 36 State Well No. 2 (**API No. 30-025-29108**) located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 36; and
- B. the New Mexico 36 State Well No. 1 (**API No. 30-025-28786**) to be re-entered and re-completed at a location 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of said Section 36.

Although Roca proposes these wells share the same spacing unit, they will produce from two distinctly different reservoirs in the EK Bone Springs Pool. The New Mexico 36 State Well No. 2 is currently producing at an approximate depth of 9,500 feet from the Second Bones Springs Sand. The First Bone Springs does not appear productive in this well because the upper part of the sand is not present. The New Mexico 36 State



Well No. 1 is currently producing at its economic limit from the Morrow formation at a depth of 13,300 feet. Roca proposes to recompletion this well to the First Bones Springs Sand at an approximate depth of 8,850 feet. This is the next potentially productive zone in the well because the Second Bone Springs Sand is drained by offset wells.

Approval of this application will result in the efficient recovery of hydrocarbons, prevent waste and will not violate correlative rights.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit A** is a plat showing the location of the two wells and the offset operators adjoining this spacing unit. **Exhibit B** are copies of the resistively logs indicating the Bone Spring sand tops and **Exhibit C** are copies of the porosity logs showing the current and proposed perforations.

Exhibit A also lists the parties affected by this application as defined by Rule 1210. A notice of this application has been provided in accordance with the provisions of Rule 1210(B) by providing a copy of this application to the affected parties by certified mail-return receipt requested advising them that if they have an objection to this application it must be filed in writing with the Division's Santa Fe office within twenty days after the filing of this application and proof of notice with the Division.


Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:
