### REQUEST FOR ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL FOR NONSTANDARD LOCATION FOR RICHARDSON OPERATING COMPANY'S NV NAVAJO 15 #4 GAS WELL

2160' FSL & 2175' FEL SEC. 15, T. 29 N., R. 14 W., SAN JUAN COUNTY, NM

I. The well is staked on Navajo Tribal Trust surface and on 1,632 acre Navajo Tribal Trust lease 14-20-603-2199. The proposed well is nonstandard for the West Kutz Pictured Cliffs and the Basin Fruitland coal gas due to terrain (wetlands) and land uses (houses, irrigated fields). The well must be  $\geq$ 660' from all quarter section lines. Thus, it is 180' too far north and 195' too far west. It is nonstandard to the other quarter sections of Section 15. The APD is attached (EXHIBIT A).

Richardson controls all Pictured Cliff and Fruitland coal gas rights in a 3,120' radius (see Exhibit B). Closest non-Richardson operated acreage is the east half Section 10.

- II. A C-102 (Exhibit C) showing the well location and pro ration units (solid line marking the east half = 320 acres for the Fruitland and a dashed line marking the southeast quarter = 160 acres for the Pictured Cliffs) is attached. Richardson's lease 14-20-603-2199 (= solid line) is shown on Exhibit D) of the Kirtland USGS topo map.
- III. According to NM Oil Conservation Records; there is no existing or proposed production from the Fruitland or Pictured Cliffs within a 3,252' radius. Closest such well is Richardson's Navajo Tribal H 12 at 1830' FNL & 810' FWL 14-29n-14w. A copy of the Kirtland 7.5' USGS map (Exhibit E) is attached showing the proposed well site and other proposed or existing gas wells in Section 15 and the eight surrounding sections. Richardson is the operator of all leases within 3,120'. Registered letters were sent on July 21 and 26, 2003 to the affected interest owners. Copies are attached.
- IV. The proposed well and Basin Fruitland coal gas pro ration unit (east half Section 15 = 320 acres) are marked on the attached copy of the Kirtland USGS map (Exhibit F). Solid line represents the pro ration unit. Dashed line represents the drilling window.

The proposed well and Pictured Cliffs pro ration unit (southeast

quarter of Section 15 = 160 acres) are both marked on Exhibit G. Solid line represents the pro ration unit. Dashed line represents the drilling window.

- V. Terrain and land use force a nonstandard location. All of the drilling windows are covered (See Exhibit H) by San Juan River wetlands, irrigated farm fields, or too close to houses (BIA mandates a 500' setback).
- VI. Archaeology is not an issue.
- VII. The nonstandard location is requested because of terrain and land use (See V. above).
- VIII. Directional drilling is not feasible for such a shallow (975') well.
- IX. I hereby certify that notice has been sent to the below lessees, lessors, operators of spacing units, or owners of undrilled leases which adjoin the applicant's spacing unit on one or more of the two sides or the single closest corner to the proposed well and that the information is current and correct. Richardson is force pooling 65 unleased mineral owners and their  $\approx$ 32 acres in the west half of Section 15 and their  $\approx$ 24 acres in the northeast quarter of Section 15.



Water zones will be protected with casing, cement, and weighted mud. Fresh water encountered during drilling will be recorded by depth, cased, and cemented. Oil and gas shows will be tested for commercial potential based on the well site geologist's recommendations.

### 3. PRESSURE CONTROL

The drilling contract has not yet been awarded, thus the exact BOP model to be used is not yet known. (A typical 2,000 psi model is on PAGE 3.) Double ram or annular system with a rotating head will be used. All ram preventers and related equipment will be hydraulically tested at nipple up and after any use under pressure to 1000 psi.

Blind rams will be hydraulically activated and checked for operational readiness each time pipe is pulled out of the hole. All checks of the BOP stack and equipment will be noted on the daily drilling report. BOP equipment will include a kelly, floor safety valve, and choke manifold all rated to 2000 psi. Maximum expected pressure is =390 psi.


Surface casing will be cemented to surface with  $\approx 36$  cubic feet ( $\approx 30$  sacks) Class B + 2% CaCl<sub>2</sub>. Volume is based on 100% excess, yield of 1.18 cubic feet per sack, and slurry weight of 15.6 pounds per gallon. W. O. C. = 12 hours. Pressure test surface casing to 600 psi for 30 minutes.

Production casing hole will first be cleaned of rock chips by circulating at least 150% of hole volume with mud to the surface. Thirty barrels of fresh water will next be circulated. Lead with  $\approx 115$  cubic feet ( $\approx 56$  sacks) of Class B with 2% metasilicate (yield = 2.06 cubic feet per sack, slurry weight = 12.5 pounds per gallon). Tail with  $\approx 70$  cubic feet ( $\approx 60$  sacks) of Class B with 2% CaCl<sub>2</sub> (yield = 1.18 cubic feet per sack, slurry weight = 15.6 pounds per gallon). Total cement volume is  $\approx 185$  cubic feet based on 75% excess and circulating to surface.

Production casing will have 4-1/2" cement guide shoe and self fill float collar. Float will be placed one joint above the shoe. Five centralizers will be spaced on every other joint starting above the shoe. Five turbolizers will be placed on every other joint starting from the top of the well.

### 5. MUD PROGRAM

Steel mud tanks will be used instead of a reserve pit. Surface casing hole will be drilled with fresh water. Production casing hole will be drilled with a fresh water polymer mud. Weighting material will be drill solids or, if needed, barite. Maximum expected mud weight will be 8.7 pounds per gallon. Sufficient material to maintain mud properties, control lost circulation, and contain a blowout will be available at the well while drilling.

### 6. CORING, TESTING, & LOGGING

No cores or drill stem tests are planned. Induction/GR and density log will be run from TD to surface.

### 7. DOWN HOLE CONDITIONS

No abnormal pressures, temperatures, nor hydrogen sulfide are expected. Maximum pressure will be ≈390 psi.

### 8. OTHER INFORMATION

The anticipated spud date is upon approval. It is expected it will take two days to drill and one week to complete the well.

### 1. DIRECTIONS & EXISTING ROADS (See Pages 10 & 11)

From the San Juan River bridge in southwest Farmington ...
Go southwest on NM 371 to the equivalent of Milepost 105.9
Then turn right and go west 2.6 miles on paved N-36
Then turn right onto wide dirt N road and go north 0.2 mi. to a sewage lagoon Then turn left below the sewage lagoon and a follow the road west 0.6 miles
Then turn right through a gate and go north 0.25 miles
Then turn left and go W 125' on an existing road which crosses the pad

Roads will be maintained to a standard at least equal to their present condition.

### 2. ROAD TO BE BUILT OR UPGRADED

No road will be built. No upgrade is needed.

### 3. EXISTING WELLS (See Page 11)

Five plugged and abandoned, seven water wells, and eight oil or gas wells are within a mile radius according to NM Oil Conservation Division and NM Office of the State Engineer records. There are no disposal wells within a mile.

### 4. PROPOSED PRODUCTION FACILITIES (See Page 14)

A meter run, two ≤400 barrel above grade tanks, and separator will be installed on the pad. One tank will hold produced water. One tank will hold

condensate. Surface equipment will be painted a flat juniper green color. Two =3" SDR-11 polyethylene pipelines will be buried by Richardson in one =36" deep trench. The trench will run northeast for 206.55' to an existing gas pipeline. One pipeline will flow gas northeast. The other pipeline will periodically flow condensate southwest. (Condensate collects in the existing pipeline and must be removed lest it freeze and block the line.) All of the route is on lease.

Pipelines will operate at  $\approx 50$  psi. Test pressure will be  $\approx 128$  psi. Test medium will be the well's own gas. Burst pressure = 630 psi at 60° Celsius. Wall thickness  $\approx 0.318$ ". Joints will be heat fused. Route will be posted with markers.

### 5. WATER SUPPLY

Water will be trucked from a private water source in Farmington.

### 6. CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS & METHODS

NM One Call (1-800-321-ALERT) will be notified before construction starts. Soil and brush will be stripped and stored as a two foot high berm around the spad. No reserve pit will be built. Steel mud tanks will be used instead. Tank contents will be hauled to nearby Richardson reserve pits.

### 7. WASTE DISPOSAL

All trash will be placed in a portable trash cage and hauled to the county landfill. There will be no trash burning. Once dry, contents of the reserve pit will be buried in place. Human waste will be disposed of in chemical toilets. Toilet contents will be hauled to an approved dump station.

There will be no air strips or camps. Camper trailers may be on location for the company man, tool pusher, or mud logger.

### 9. WELL SITE LAYOUT

See Pages 12 and 13 for depictions of the well pad, cross section, cut and fill diagram, trash cage, access onto the location, parking, living facilities, and rig orientation.

### 10. RECLAMATION

The pad will be contoured to a natural appearance and disturbed areas ripped or harrowed. BLM "down south" (aka, dry or low mix or mix #2) seed mix (below) will be drilled at a depth and time to be determined by BLM.








### NV Nava jo 15 # 4 well pad and section



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
