This letter acknowledges the receipt of your administrative application dated August 8, 2001, to downhole commingle the Mesaverde, Chacra and Dakota formations in the Jicarilla "A" No. 8E located in Section 17, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The Division received your application on August 13, 2001.

Our preliminary review indicates that the information provided in the application is not sufficient to process the administrative order. The following information is necessary:

- b) **Has the BLM been notified of the proposed downhole commingling?**
