Administrative Permit Order SWD-1017 approved the JM Denton Well No. 6 (API No. 30-025-05280) for injection of salt water into the Pennsylvanian formation from 9600 feet to 10150 feet through plastic coated tubing.

As per your request on behalf of the current operator, Legacy Reserves Operating, LP, received in this office on November 27, 2006, and for the reasons outlined in your letter, the deadline for commencement of injection is hereby extended until December 29, 2007.

Provided: The operator shall not begin injection into this well until all pre-conditions contained in the original order are complied with.

The injection authority for this well shall expire on December 29, 2007, if the operator has not commenced injection operations.
