We request permission to drill and produce with a full unit allowable the Chaco Unit No. 2, a wildcat, 660' from the South and 2130' from the East lines of Section 16, T-23N, R-8W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The SE quarter of Section 16 has been designated as the drilling unit and the most probable production will be oil from the Tocito Formation.

*SE* Topographic conditions make this location the best location in this quarter section.

Additional acreage can be assigned to this well if necessary. The well is in the Chaco Unit, Unit #14-08-001-2026, and Great Western Drilling Company is the Unit Operator.
