As Operator of the Northeast Blanco Unit, we request permission to drill an unorthodox well, to be located 285' from the North line and 2330' from the East line of Section 4, T 30 N, R 7 W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

In order to drill a well in this quarter section, which will be above the 6,100 feet contour line of the proposed Navajo Dam Project, it is necessary to select a more appropriate location for a drilling site.

Section 4, T 30 N, R 7 W is a part of the Northeast Blanco Unit and the new location, as requested, will present no drainage problems to offset operators.

We enclose a location plat for the requested unorthodox location.

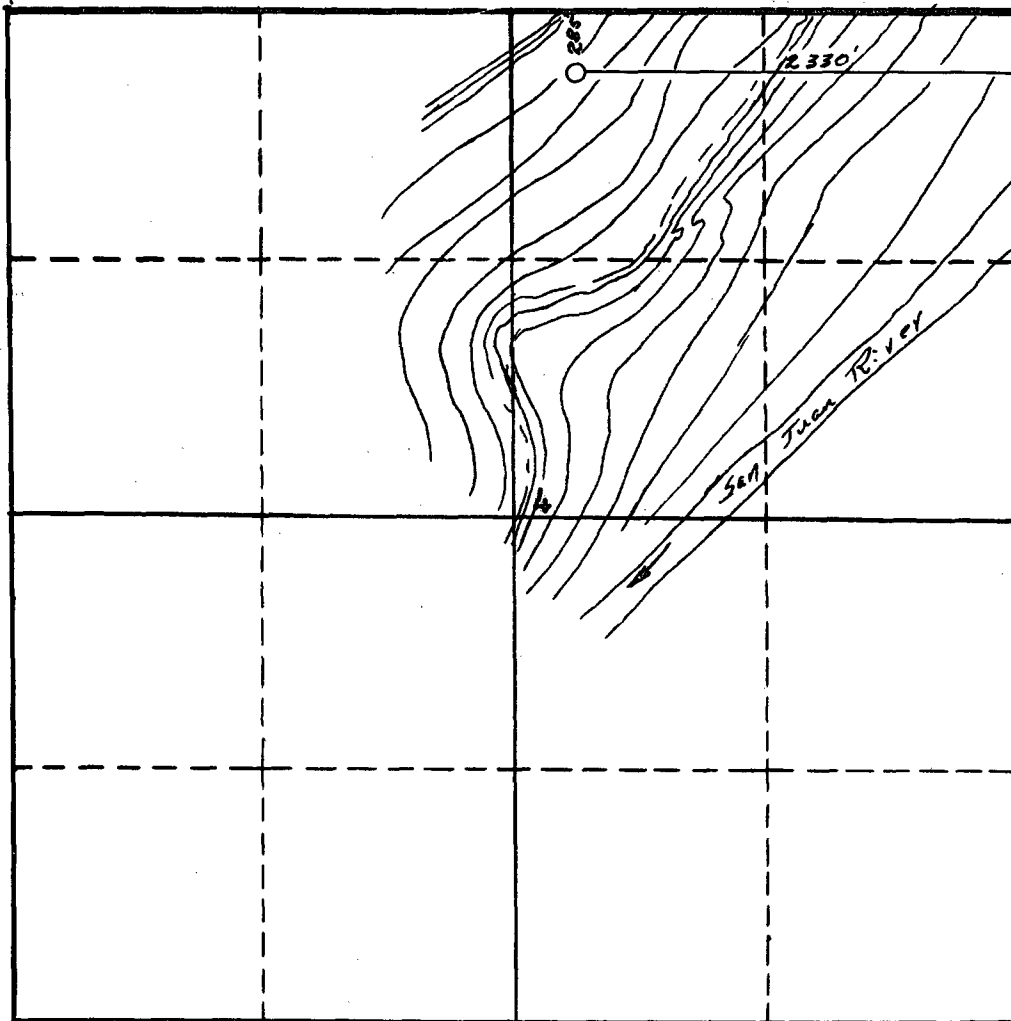
