Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your San Juan Unit 28-6 Well No. 75-3 to be located 750 feet from the South line and 1850 feet from the West line and in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, Blanco Mesaverde Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section.
