Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Nickson Well No. 4 to be located 490 feet from the South line and 1890 feet from the West line and in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 14, Township 26 North, Range 8 West, Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SW/4 of said Section 14.

Inasmuch as you own all offsetting acreage, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 3 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Ballard Pictured Cliffs Pool, as set forth in Order R-846, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 3 of said Order R-846 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
