Gentlemen:

Humble Oil & Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval of an unorthodox location for its South Chaco Unit, Well No. 4. This well is located 1130 feet from the North and 1130 feet from the East lines of Section 10, Township 22 North, Range 8 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

We support our application with the following statements:

1. The necessity for the unorthodox location is based on topographical conditions.
2. The ownership of all gas and oil leases within a radius of 790 feet of the location is common with the ownership of the gas and oil leases under the location.
3. All offset operators were notified by registered mail of our application for approval of this unorthodox location.
4. The well was projected to a gas producing horizon and was located as such. Production is from an oil producing horizon resulting in an unorthodox location.

A Revised Form C-128 is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge the location of the well.

In view of the facts set out herein, it is respectfully requested that the Commission approve the unorthodox location of this well.




