Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Nearburg & Ingram No. 1-X Johnston Well to be located 2340 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line and in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, Red Lake Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NW/4 SW/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you furniabed waivers from the offset operators, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted.
