Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your A. M. York Well No. 1 located 2310 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line and in the NE/4 of Section 20, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Blinbry Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is occasioned by the recompletion of said A. M. York Well No. 1 in another horizon.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 3 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blinbry Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-610, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 2 of Order R-610 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
