Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your dually completed Lockhart Well No. 1 located 2310 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line and in the W/2 SW/4 of Section 17, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Blinbry and Tubb Gas Pools, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is occasioned by the recompletion of a well previously drilled to another horizon.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 3 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinbry and Tubb Gas Pools, as set forth in Orders R-610 and R-586, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 2 of Orders R-610 and R-586 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
