Re: San Juan Drilling Company - Jackson No. 2  
Unit K - Section 30- 30-N, 11-W, San Juan County

The San Juan Drilling Company (Incorporated in Delaware ) is the owner of an oil and gas lease covering the entire South half of Section 30, Township 30-N, Range 11-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

In June, while the lease was still in the name of Mr. Robert Mims, a Notice of Intention to Drill a well known as the Mims-Jackson No. 2 in Unit K, Section 30 was filed with the Aztec office of the Commission.

The well was drilled as a Dakota Wildcat and no production was found in the Dakota formation. It was, however, possible to plug the well back to the Pictured Cliffs formation and complete the well as a gas producer from that sand.

This has been done, and the San Juan Drilling Company (Incorporated in Delaware) has made a contract with the El Paso Natural Gas Company to sell the gas.

You will note from the attached copy of Form C-128 that the well is located 1,980 feet from the West line and 1,980 feet from the South line of Sec. 30.

We respectfully request permission to sell the Pictured Cliffs gas from this well.

The San Juan Drilling Company (Incorporated in Delaware) owns the gas and oil rights to the entire South half of the Section.

We are informed that the forty acres immediately to the North of the well was a part of the estate of A. G. Ramsauer and we are furnishing the heirs with a copy of this letter as noted below.

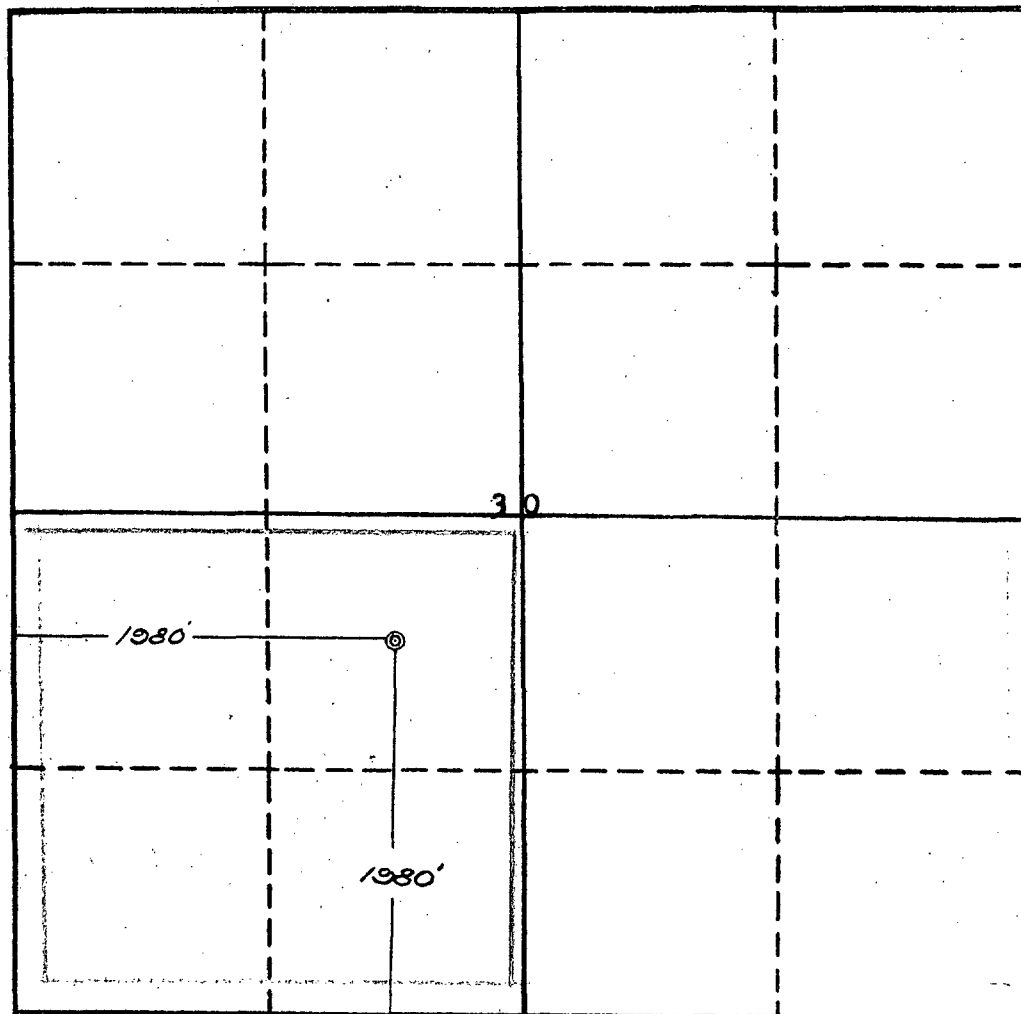

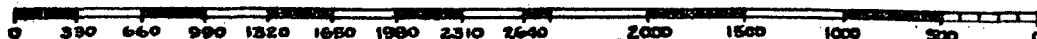

Dear Mr. Neal:

This is to notify you that the Oil Conservation Commission inadvertently approved Form C-110 on the San Juan Drilling Company #2 Jackson located in Unit X, Section 30-30N-11W, Asteo Pictured Cliffs Pool. This well was originally drilled as a Dakota wildcat and was spaced as an oil well location. The well was later plugged back and completed as a gas well in the Pictured Cliffs formation.

It will be necessary that administrative approval of the non-standard location be secured before the well may be produced. This approval must be secured from Mr. A. L. Porter, Director of the Commission, Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico.
