Gentlemen:


It is hereby requested that an unorthodox location be authorized for the A. N. Spanel-W. O. Heinze Santa Fe-Pacific Railroad Company Well No. 1-9612, which well is to be located 700 feet from the South line and 1070 feet from the West line of Section 5, Township 5 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Valencia County, New Mexico. The reason for the necessity of locating the well at this point is extreme topographical conditions.

The operators own all acreage within 660 feet of the proposed location. It is respectfully requested that administrative exception to Rule 104(b) be granted.
