Pursuant to Rule 104(f), Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits, in triplicate, its application for administrative approval of an exception to the well location regulations set forth in Rule 104(c).

In support of this application, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

- 1. The proposed unorthodox drilling location has been staked one thousand and thirty-five feet (1,035') from the North line and one thousand and one hundred and fifteen feet (1,115') from the West line of Section 34, T-29-N, R-13-W, N.M.P.M., and this unorthodox location is necessitated by topographical conditions.
- 2. The ownership of all oil and gas leases within a radius of 790 feet of the proposed location is common with the ownership of the oil and gas leases under the proposed location, Applicant holding the entire section under lease.
- 3. Applicant intends to drill a well on the unorthodox drilling location to be known as the Hagood No. 6-G to an approximate depth of five thousand six hundred and fifty feet (5,650') and expects to complete it as an oil producer.

Applicant respectfully requests that the Secretary-Director of the Commission, by administrative approval, grant exception, as above provided, without notice and hearing, approving the unorthodox drilling location set forth above.
