This will refer to Administrative Order NSL-230 granting approval of an unorthodox oil well location for Pan American's Navajo Tribal "E" No. 4 at 1115 feet from the north line and 2125 feet from the west line of Section 21, T-29-N, R-14-W, San Juan County, New Mexico, for reasons of topographic necessity.

Other regulatory agencies have required that the well location for Navajo Tribal "E" No. 4 be moved to 660 feet from the north line and 1890 feet from the west line of Section 21, T-29-N, R-14-W, which is an orthodox drill site. Thus, the non-standard location is no longer necessary and should be cancelled.

We appreciate your cooperation in handling the previous request for the unorthodox location.
