Dear Mr. Porter:

By this letter I am hereby requesting administrative approval of a non-standard location for the captioned well. Enclosed please find three (3) copies of the well location and acreage dedication plat which shows the inaccessible terrain to the south of the well location. To move the location further south would result in prohibitive expense. It should also be noted that we own the lease to the west in Section 19 and have already drilled and completed a Dakota well to which this acreage has been dedicated. This well is known as the #2 Sunical Federal-D. The N/2 of Section 20, which is offsetting acreage to the north of the #4 Sunical Federal-D location, is also owned by our Company and dedicated to the #3 Sunical Federal-D well, which has also been drilled and completed. The acreage originally dedicated to the #3 well was the W/2 of Section 20 but we have subsequently rededicated the N/2 of Section 20 to this well so the #4 well could be drilled in the SW/4 of that Section. We feel that this location has the best geological merit for obtaining commercial production.

Your rapid consideration of this matter would be greatly appreciated as we are ready to commence drilling operations.




