Gentlemen:

Please consider this our formal application to you for administrative approval for the drilling of the captioned well at the subject non-standard location.

On April 2, 1965, Mr. Gene Snow, our Production Superintendent, accompanied the John W. West Engineering Company's survey party to the Indian Basin Field area. At that time, we selected the drillsite at the only feasible location in the northwest quarter of the section and which would deviate the least from the established spacing pattern of the field. A location anywhere else in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ would be excessively expensive to construct due to a ravine with extreme relief on the east and south of the subject location. Another factor considered in the selection was that of safety and accessibility should any difficulty with high pressure gas and threatened blow-out and fire be encountered. Topographically, the drillsite selected affords us maximum advantage to combat any such problem. Mr. W. A. Gressett of your Artesia office visited the proposed location on April 3, 1965. At that time, he examined the area thoroughly.

Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the pool requires all offset operators be notified of the application. We hereby state that certified notices have been sent to same and enclosed herewith are copies of such notification. Copies of signed waivers will be forwarded to you as soon as they are received by this office.

Gentlemen:

We plan to communitize the subject section for the drilling of said well. We find that due to topographical reasons a location 1650 feet from the north and west lines, to comply with field rules, would be entirely impractical. We are therefore applying to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for approval to drill an unorthodox location.

In order to gain administrative approval from the N.M.O.C.C., we are in need of signed waivers from all offset leaseholders. Since you are an offset leaseholder by virtue of your lease in Section 8, Township 22 South, Range 24 East, we are enclosing two copies of waivers for execution by your company.

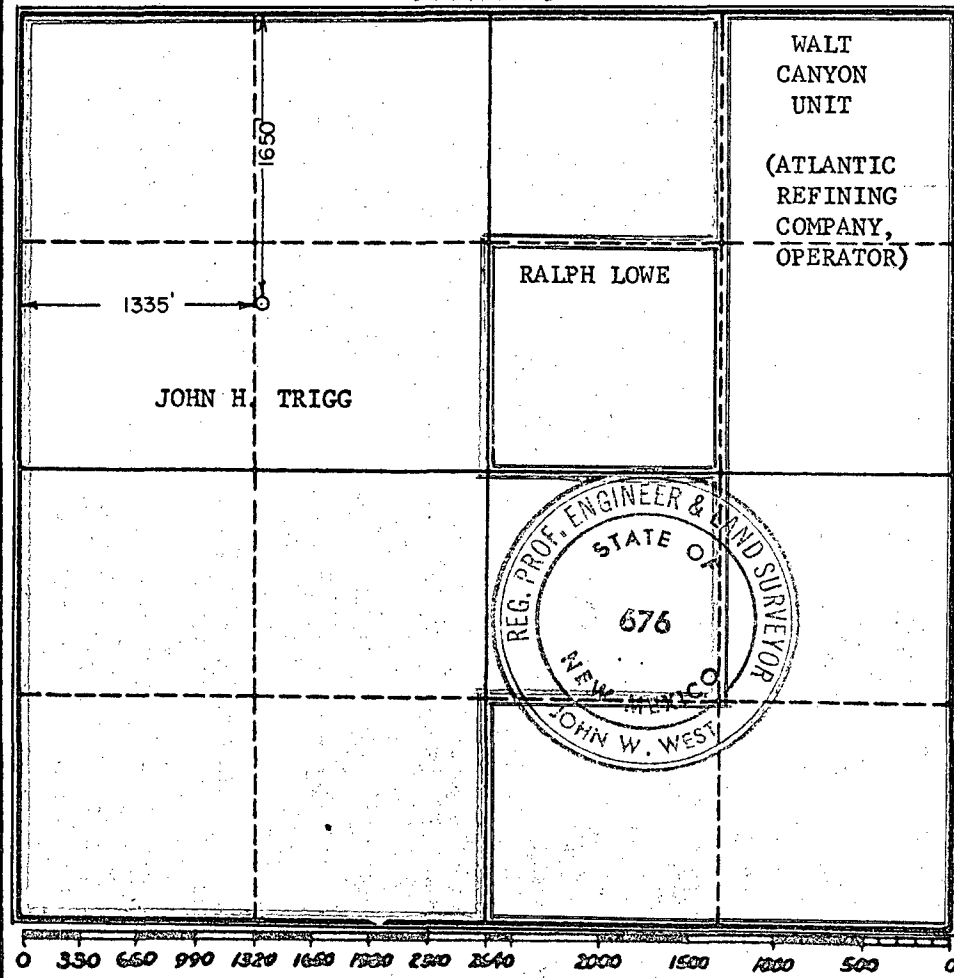


