Amended Administrative Order NSL-375-A

Dear Mr. Bradshaw:

Reference is made to your application dated April 9, 1991 to amend Division Administrative Order NSL-375-A and rededicate to the Uncle Com Well No. 1 the E/2 NW/4 of Section 28, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit in the South Corbin-Wolfcamp Pool.

Meridian Oil Inc. as applicant having properly notified all offset operators of this acreage rededication and with no objection filed by any interested party within the twenty-day waiting period prescribed by Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Corbin-Wolfcamp Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8181-B, the above-described application is hereby approved. All references in said Order NSL-375-A to the 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the N/2 NW/4 of said Section 28 are amended to properly read the "E/2 NW/4" of said Section 28, all other provisions of Order NSL-375-A shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
