Dear Mr. Kapteina:

Enclosed herewith are forms C-101 and C-102, as per our conversation today.

We would like to request an unorthodox location under Rule 104, based on topographical conditions as follows.

First, we own all forty acre tracts surrounding the proposed location. However, this site is located in the Cimarron River bottom, and if the location should be moved west, we would get in the river, or if it would be north we would get in the old river channel, which runs lots of water in flood stage. As it is the location is on a high ridge, which is comparatively dry. Enclosed, please find plat showing ownership of forty acre tracts around proposed location.

By way of explanation, the only reason we wanted to drill from 300 to T. D. 4 3/4" was to drill on air, keep the formation clean from mud and water, and to more accurately determine what these sands contain, and then set casing.

If you should need any further information, please advise.
