Request for Amendment to Administrative Order NSL-392, Springs Unit Well No. 2,

Gulf Oil Corporation, as Operator of the Springs Unit, filed an application for a non-standard location for the Springs Unit Well No. 2 to be 1,650 feet from the south line and 990 feet from the east line of Section 27, T-20S, R-26E, Eddy County, New Mexico. The Commission granted its approval by Administrative Order NSL-392 dated January 23, 1967.

The drilling of the Springs Unit Well No. 2 has commenced; however, a resurvey revealed the location of the well to be 1,650 feet from the south line and 754 feet from the east line of Section 27. The difference in the location is due to the variation of the boundary lines of this Section 27.

It is respectfully requested that Administrative Order NSL-392 be amended to provide that the unorthodox well location shall be 1,650 feet from the south line and 754 feet from the east line of Section 27, T-20S, R-26E, Eddy County, New Mexico. All offset acreage to the non-standard location is in the Springs Unit; therefore, no approval from offset operators is applicable.
