
Dear Mr. Hatch:

Enclosed is a copy of Well Location and Acreage Dedication plat for our proposed North Hogback 6 No. 2 test. Also enclosed for your information are copies of our letter to the Oil Conservation Commission in Aztec dated June 3rd and their reply dated June 7th.

As noted on the plat, the location is staked 130' from the south line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6. It is impossible to move the location to the north because of the group of buildings which is also shown on the plat. Walter Duncan is lessee of all of Section 6 under Navajo Tribal Lease 14-20-0603-10008. Mr. Weldon Julander has a Designation of Operator covering the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of this section; however, that acreage is in no way affected by our proposed location.

Your early consideration and approval of this location are respectfully requested. If there is any other information you need in this regard, please let us know.

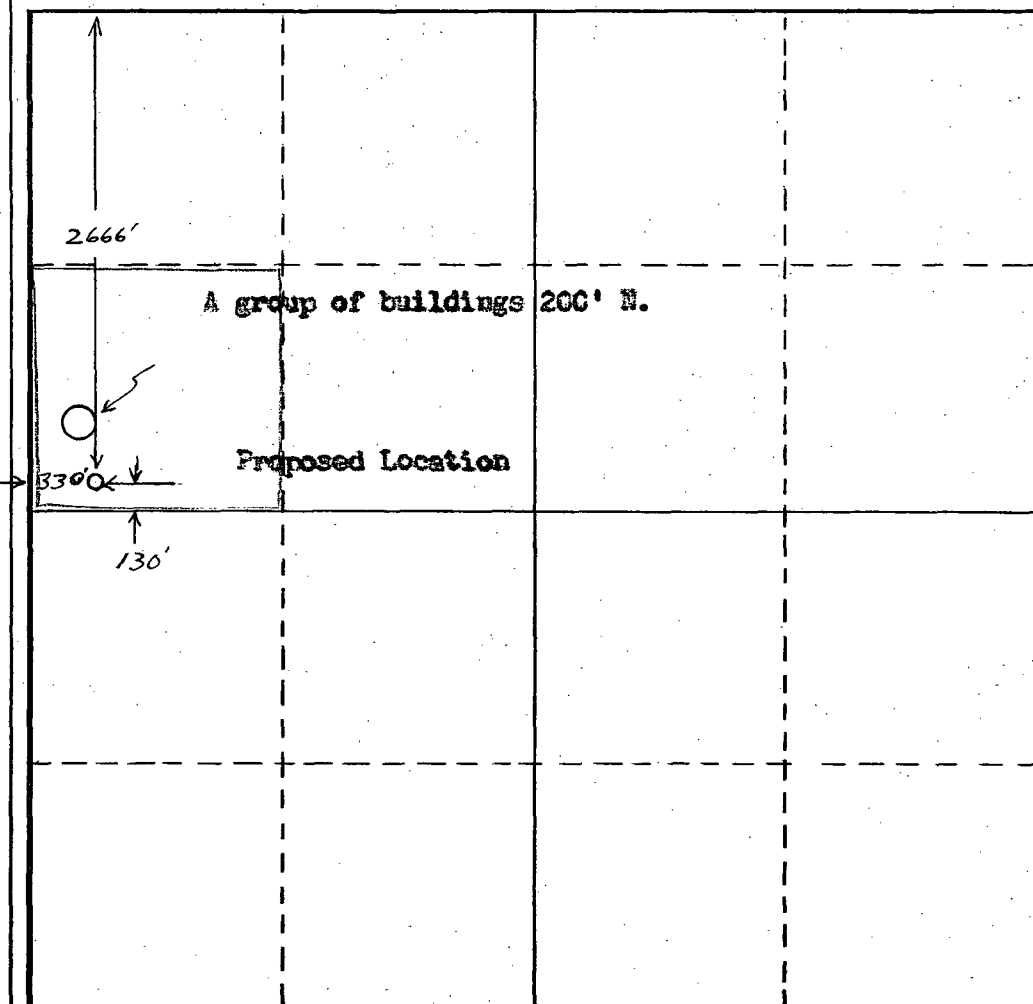
