Gentlemen:

On behalf of Texas American Oil Corporation, I wish to apply to the Oil Conservation Commission for administrative approval of an unorthodox well location in Eddy County, New Mexico, as provided by Commission Rule 104 D II F., based upon the completion of a well previously drilled to another horizon.

Texas American Oil Corporation drilled its Sullivan Federal No. 1 well at a location 660 feet from the South line, and 660 feet from the West line of Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 24 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was originally projected as a Devonian oil test, and 40 acres were dedicated to the well when the notice of intention to drill was filed with the Commission.

The well was subsequently recompleted in the Morrow formation, testing 880 MCF dry gas per day from 8163 feet to 8513 feet perforated interval. 320 acres have been dedicated to the well.

Since this well appears to be more than one mile from the nearest Morrow production, it would appear that a new pool should be created for Morrow production.

Your consideration of this application will be appreciated.


