Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests your approval to drill a development well in the North Vacuum-Abo Oil Pool at an unorthodox location. It is proposed to drill Lea "FE" State No. 6 well 2180' from the north line and 610' from the east line of Section 11, T-17S, R-34E, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached plat. In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

1. The Special Rules and Regulations for the North Vacuum-Abo Pool were promulgated effective March 1, 1963.
2. Applicant believes the drilling of this well represents reasonable development in the North Vacuum-Abo Oil Pool.
3. As shown by the attached plat, the unorthodox location is necessitated by the proximity of a high line.
4. This application is in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste.
5. Waivers of the objection to this application by the offset operators, Pennzoil United Inc., Mobil Oil Co., and Amini Oil Corp., are attached.

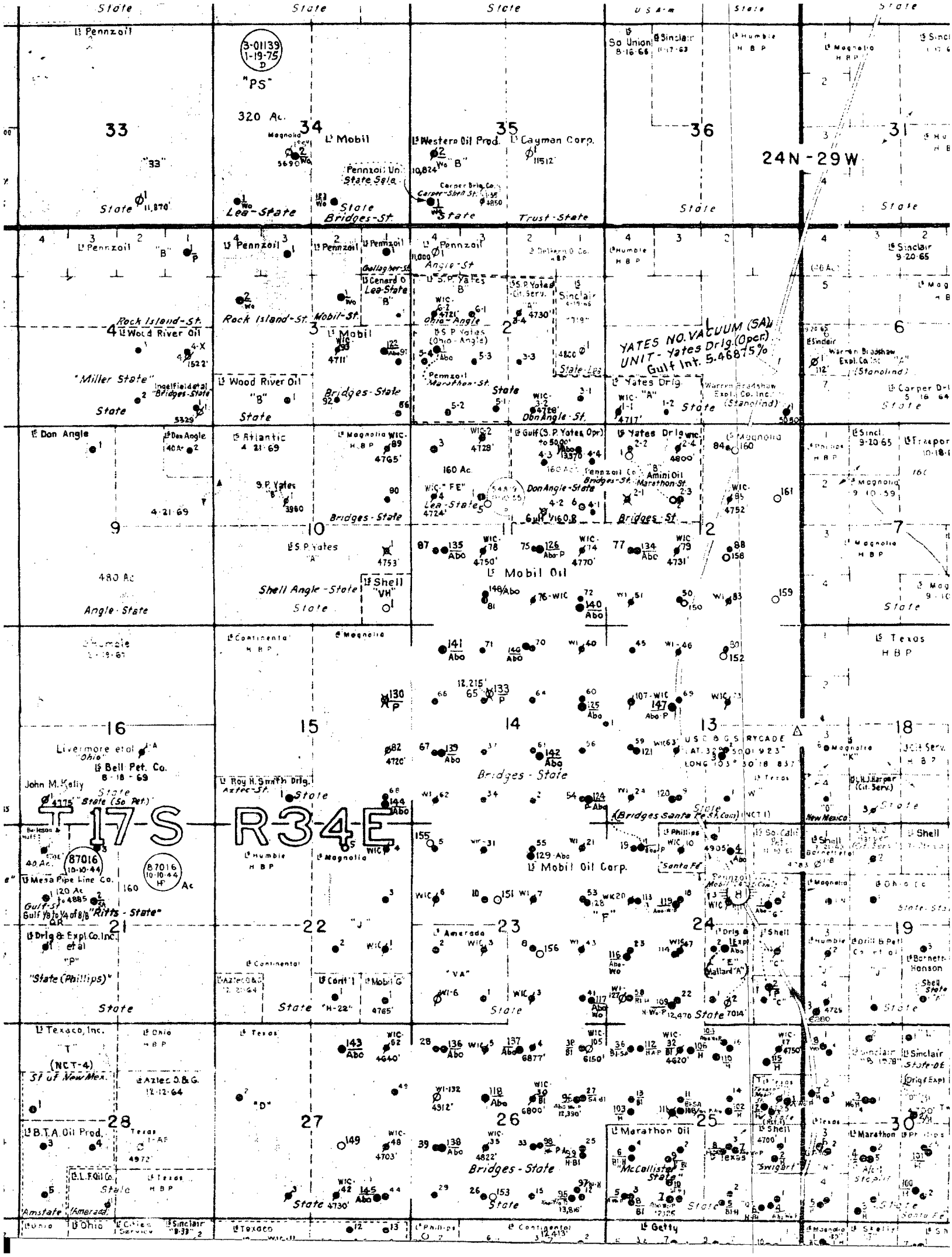

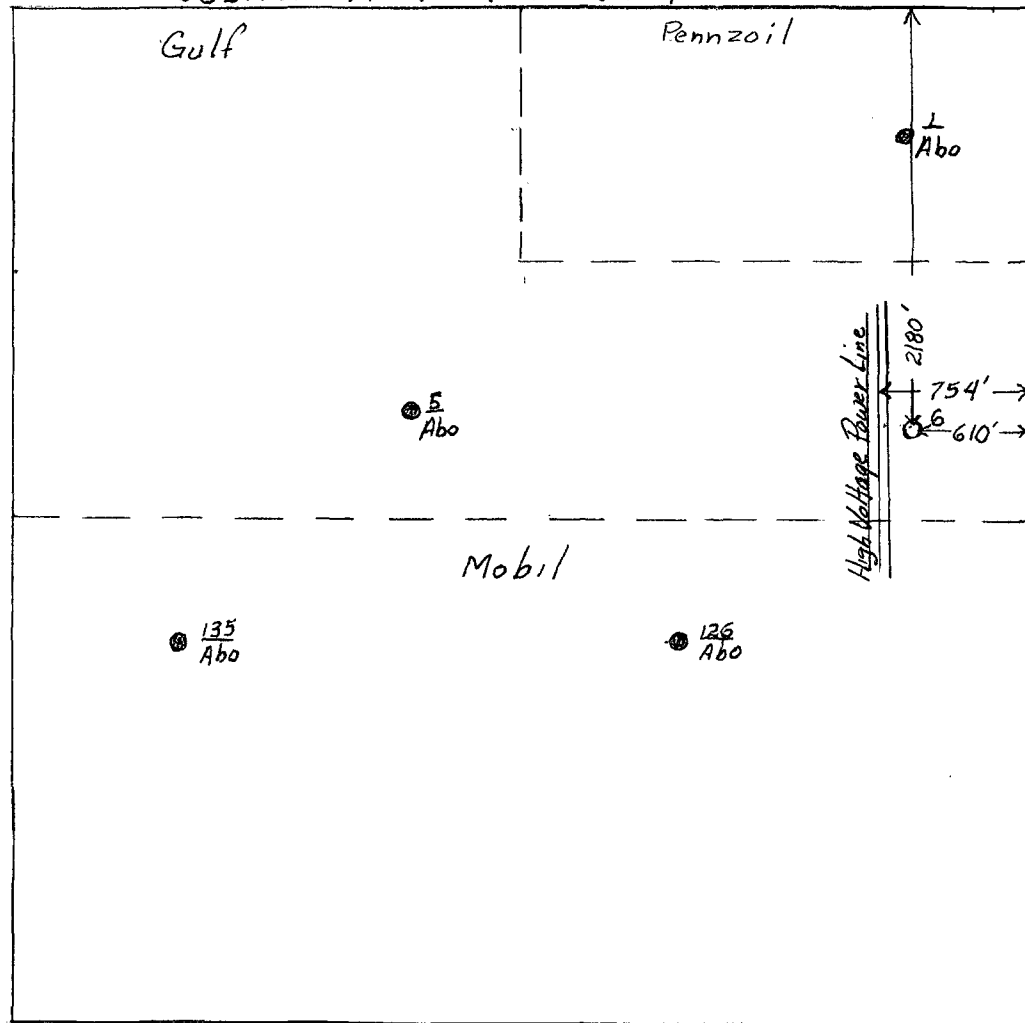
