The well was squeezed off in the Paddock Oil Zone and completed in the Tubb Gas Zone 3-18-71. Necessary forms have been sent to the Oil Conservation Commission requesting establishment of a 160-acre standard Tubb Gas Proration Unit, located in the NW/4 of Section 23 as shown on the attached plat.

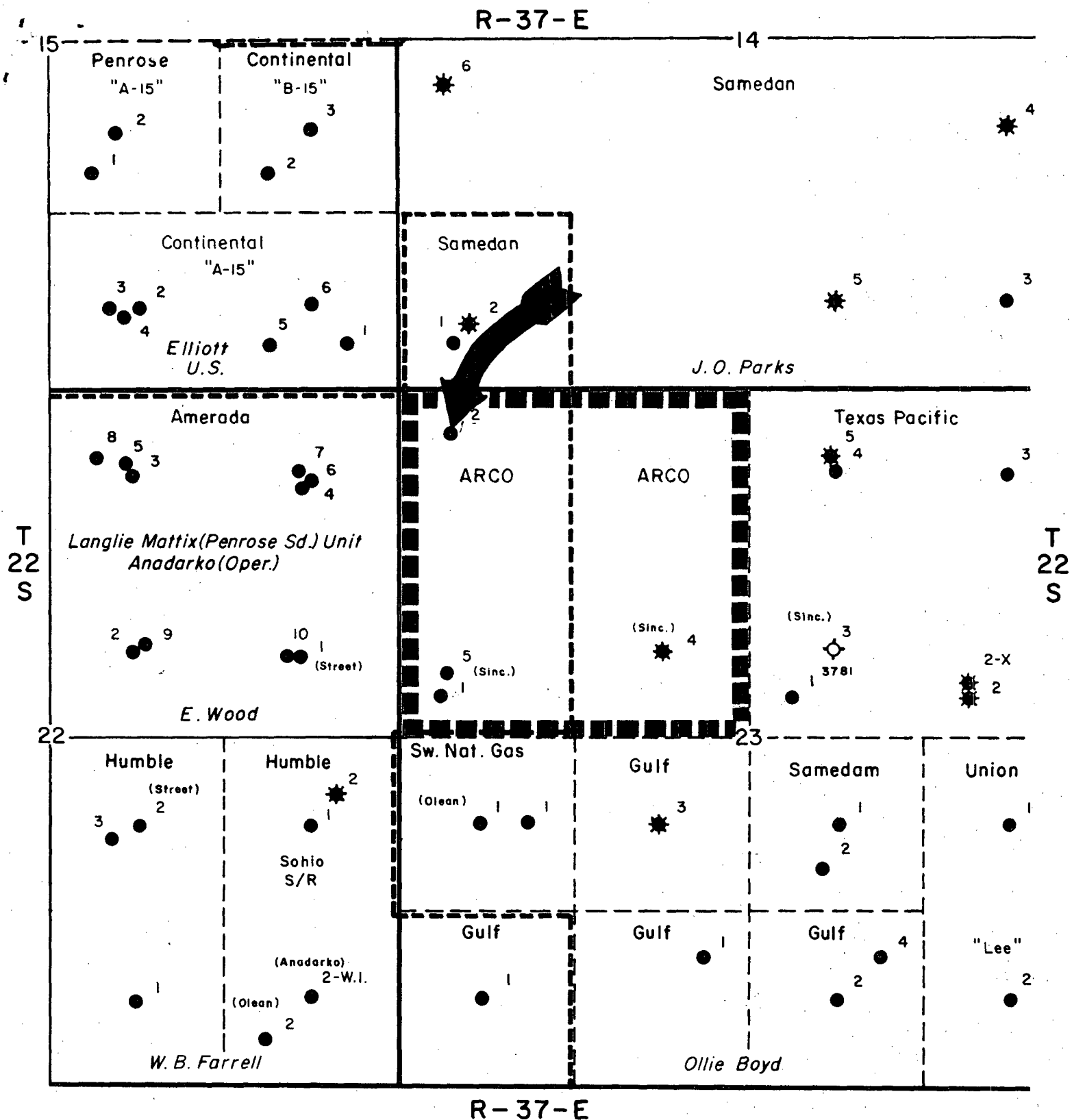
