Dear Mr. Porter:

Pursuant to the rules of N.M.O.C.C. Order No. R-3199, I hereby  
apply for a non-standard location for the captioned well in the Chaco  
Wash-Mesaverde Oil Pool.

This well, an offset to the Scanlon #9 dry hole, was inadver-  
tently located five feet to the south and five feet to the east of the  
old well, placing it 160 feet from the south line and 165 feet from the  
west line of Section 22, T20N, R9W, NMPM, McKinley County, New Mexico,  
rather than 165 feet from the south line as the order stated.

Inasmuch as both the south and the west offset locations are  
part of the same lease from the Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company, there  
is no breach of correlative rights.
