Dear Mr. Dawson:

Reference is made to your application dated June 14, 1993 for an 80-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in either the Undesignated Jalmart Gas Pool or Undesignated Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 29: W/2 NE/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your existing New Mexico "M" State Well No. 71 which was drilled in 1972 and completed in the Langlie-Mattix Pool at a previously approved unorthodox oil well location 70 feet from the North line and 2570 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 29 (see Division Administrative Order NSL-557, dated June 5, 1972).


It is my understanding that the Langlie-Mattix zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted up-hole to either the Undesignated Jalmart or Undesignated Eumont interval, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for both pools as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, is unorthodox.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 and 2(c) of said Special Rules and Regulations, the above non-standard gas proration unit and resulting unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.

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Said Division Order NSL-557 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
