



Dear Mr. Porter:

Walter Duncan has staked a location in the Slickrock-Dakota oil pool 2540' fnl, 330' fel, Section 1 T29N R17W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

By Order R-3252 covering the Slickrock-Dakota oil pool, no well may be drilled closer than 165' from the outer boundary of the quarter-quarter section on which it is located. We are asking for exception to Rule No. 2 of Order R-3252 due to topographic and geological reasons. Directly north of the subject location is a large irrigation ditch which prevents moving the location north by less than 200' and we feel if the location were moved a distance of 200' north the chances of making a producing well are diminished.

Walter Duncan is the lessee on all of Section 1 T29N R17W and also all of Section 6 T29N R16W; therefore, there are no off-set operators.






