Dear Mr. Porter:

May Petroleum Inc. is the operator under oil and gas leases covering the NE/4 SE/4, Section 31, Township 11 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. Our firm represents this company.

This is the written application of that company for permission to drill a well to the Devonian sand on the above acreage on an unorthodox location. It is proposed to locate the well 1,129 feet from the east boundary of the section and 1,650 feet from the south boundary of the section.

The reason for applying for an unorthodox location relates to the topography; and we seek administrative approval for this deviation from the rules, as provided in Rule 104 F.

A plat is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A" showing the proposed location. The plat further shows that there is a buried pipeline running north and west across the area as well as a dry-hole to the north and east of the proposed location. Because of the fact that a Devonian well will need a large pad to accommodate the drilling and completion, because of the close proximity of the dry-hole and because of the nearness of the power line to the west, which line is also marked on the plat, it was determined that the proposed location for the well is the logical and reasonable spot from a topographical standpoint.

EXPLANATION OF PLAT

The records of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Hobbs reflect that the wells that have been drilled on the tract on which an unorthodox location is sought, which tract is indicated on the plat as tract "A", and the offsetting acreage have all been plugged and abandoned. The owners of the operating rights are as follows:

Tract No. 1: Elk Oil Company, Roswell, New Mexico

Tract No. 2: The Wallace heirs who own the minerals. The acreage is presently unleased, according to our best information.

Tract No. 3: May Petroleum Inc., your applicant for the unorthodox location is the owner of the operating rights. Therefore, no waiver will be necessary.

Tract No. 4: The state lease on this property is held jointly by T. D. Skelton and Byron McKnight.

Tract No. 5: T. D. Skelton owns the operating rights under this tract.
