Reference is made to your application for approval of unorthodox oil well locations for your West Loco Hills G. #4 S UT Tract 32A Well No. 8, to be located 1560 feet from the South line and 1480 feet from the East line of Section 11 and your West Loco Hills No. 4S UT Tract 19A Well No. 2 to be located 880 feet from the South line and 1480 feet from the East line of Section 9, both in Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Loco Hills, Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Field, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Waivers of objection have been received from offsetting operators and the waiting period prescribed by Rule 104 F may be dispensed with in this instance.
