
A request is made for administrative approval of an unorthodox location for a 1400' Fruitland gas test location 905' FWL and 2165' FSL of Section 17, T 28N, R 11W, Pinon Fruitland Gas Field, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Consent waivers have been obtained verbally from all offsetting leasehold owners and letters from Amoco and Keyes should be in your office within the next few days.

This request is to increase the net feet of porous gas sand reservoir and to get enough distance to minimize fracing into the dryhole which is 75 feet west and 345 feet south of the proposed location. The dry arroyo immediately east and south of our proposed location was a surface problem.

Your consideration of this request will be greatly appreciated.

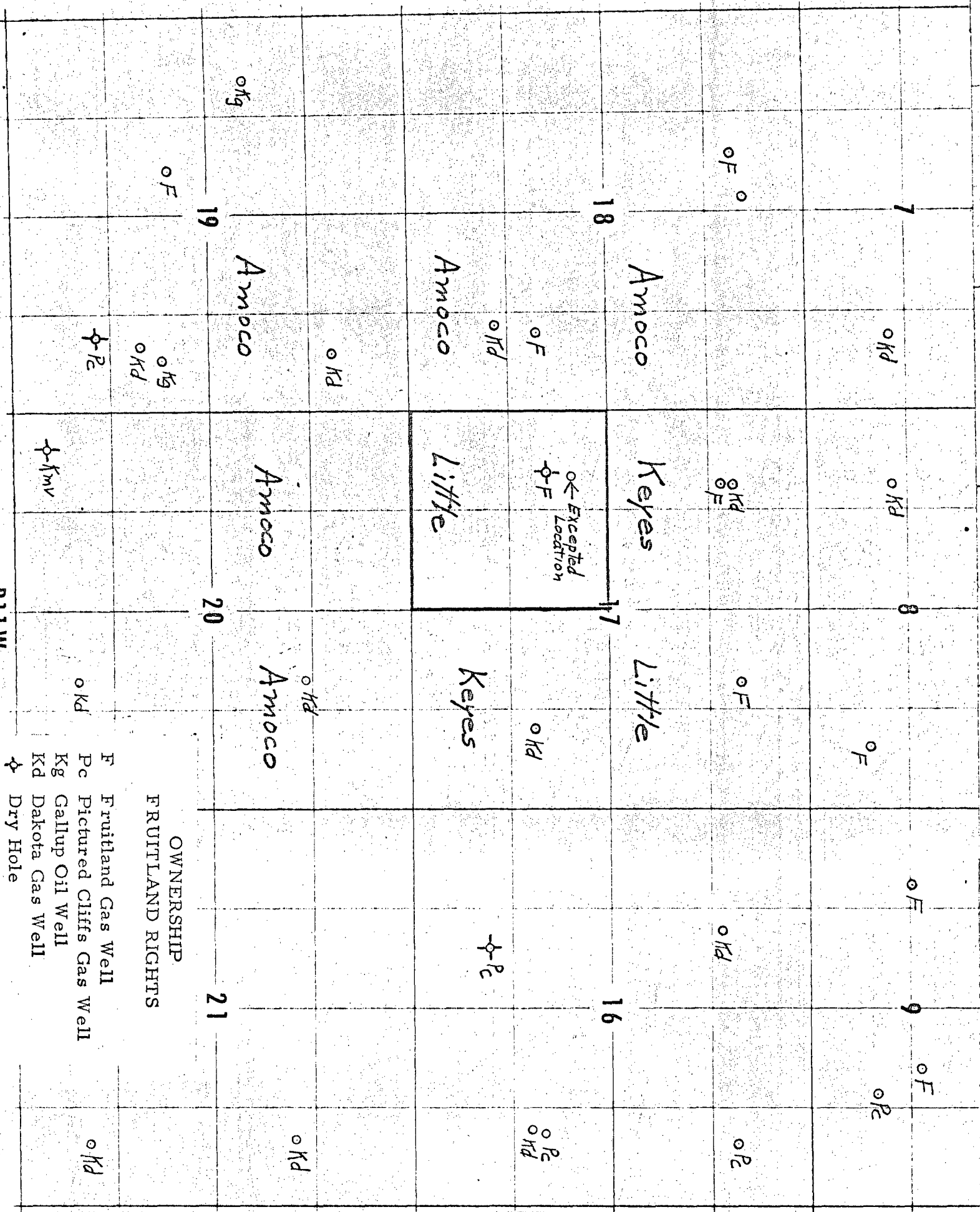
