Gentlemen:

Southern Union Supply Company proposes to re-enter the subject well and deepen same sufficient to test the Morrow formation and the time in which we are allowed to enter upon same and commence operation is very limited. The location of the old well that we propose to re-enter is situated 660 feet from the south and east lines of Section 18, T-17-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico

Should this test result as a commercial gas well the spacing will be 320 acres which would be an unorthodox location requiring us to obtain authority from the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico to grant an exception to the well location requirements set forth in Section B & C of Commission Rule 104.

Under these conditions, and in accordance with the regulation, we are requesting a waiver from all offset operators prior to requesting Secretary-Director approval.

If you are willing to agree to this waiver as an offset operator, please indicate your concurrence by signing and returning a copy of this letter.

Gentlemen:

Find attached, hereto, six executed copies of an Application for Permit to Drill, Deepen or Plug Back, being your form C-101, and also four executed copies of your Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat, form C-102; each for your consideration and approval. You will note that we propose to re-enter and deepen the old Delfern Oil Company #1-C Lea-State well which is location 660' out of the south-east corner of Section 18, T-17-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico, which is an unorthodox location if we are successful in completing it as a gas well in the Morrow formation. In as much as we are hopeful that this well will result as a commercial gas well we are in the process of obtaining waivers from all the adjacent leasehold operators as required under Section B & C of Commission Rule 104, and as soon as they have been returned to us we will forward them to you.

It is anticipated that the waivers can be readily obtained since the majority of the owners gave their consent in connection with our re-entry being our Gallagher 8 State well in Section 8, just north of this proposed location and this being the case it is hoped that you can review and approve this request at the earliest possible date.


