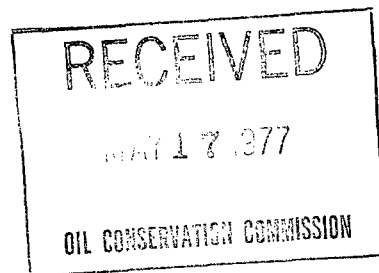

Dear Sir:

Summit Energy, Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval of the location of the Drinkard Estate No.6 Well. The location of the well is 1807' FNL, 1542' FEL, Section 25-T22S-R37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The following facts are pertinent to the consideration of this request:

1. The location had to be moved South and East to avoid buried pipelines in the area, to avoid an existing road in the area, and to avoid interference with a present tank battery and equipment.
2. Summit Energy, Inc., owns and operates on the 40 acre tract to the East of the designated and proposed well site.
3. All mineral interests in the 40 acre tract under the Drinkard Estate No. 6 Well and the 40 acre tract to the East are identical.
4. All offset operators have been furnished a copy of this request, plus copies of plats and the intention to drill.

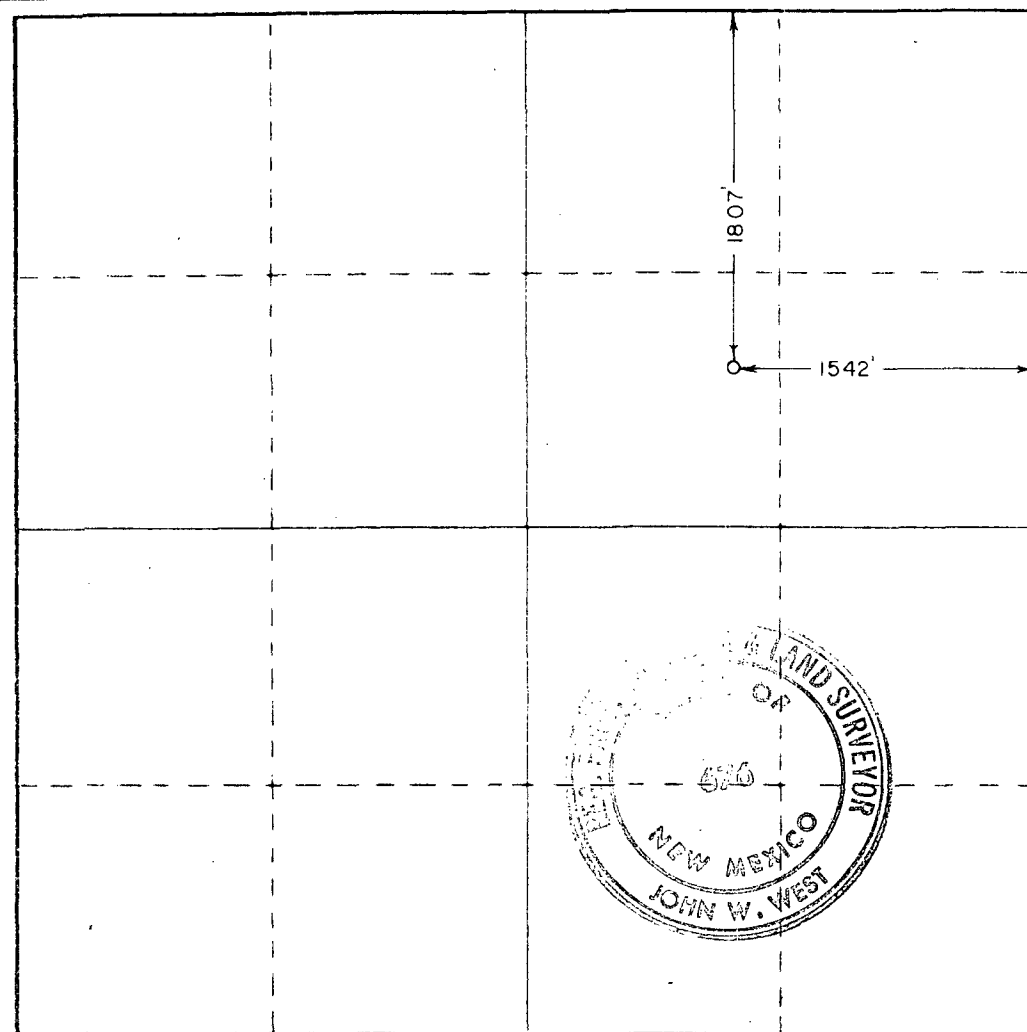

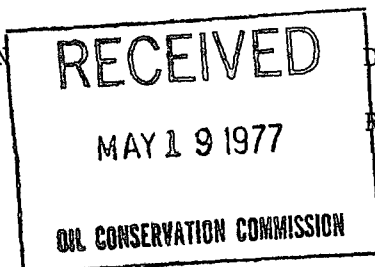

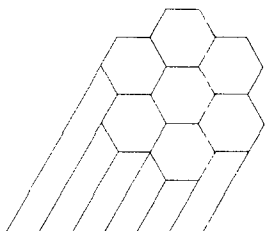

The Drinkard Estate No. 6 was drilled as a Wantz-Granite Wash well at a non-standard location of 1807' FWL and 1542' FEL of Section 25, T22S - R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The non-standard location was due to the location of Drinkard Estate No. 5 and to avoid buried pipelines and an existing road in the area. It is noted that John H. Hendrix Corporation owns and operates the tract to the east of Drinkard Estate No. 6, which is the tract nearest the non-standard location. The Wantz-Granite Wash was approved by NSL-852.

The Drinkard Estate No. 6 is a replacement well in the Brunson Drinkard-Abo, S. for the Drinkard Estate No. 5 which has been squeezed in the Brunson Drinkard-Abo, S. and temporarily abandoned due to a high pressure water flow.
