Gentlemen:

J. M. Huber Corporation, the Applicant, seeks an exception to Rule 104 for administrative approval of the subject unorthodox well location for our Huber-Terra State Well No. 3.

The intended location for this Delaware gas test well was to be 990' FSL and 1650' FWL, Section 15-23S-26E. In staking the well at this location, it was discovered that a buried pipeline, as shown on the plat attached hereto, prevented us from conducting drilling operations at this site. An alternate location was staked, and it is this location for which the Applicant seeks administrative approval.

Coquina Oil Corporation has been notified this day by certified mail of our application for approval of this unorthodox well location.

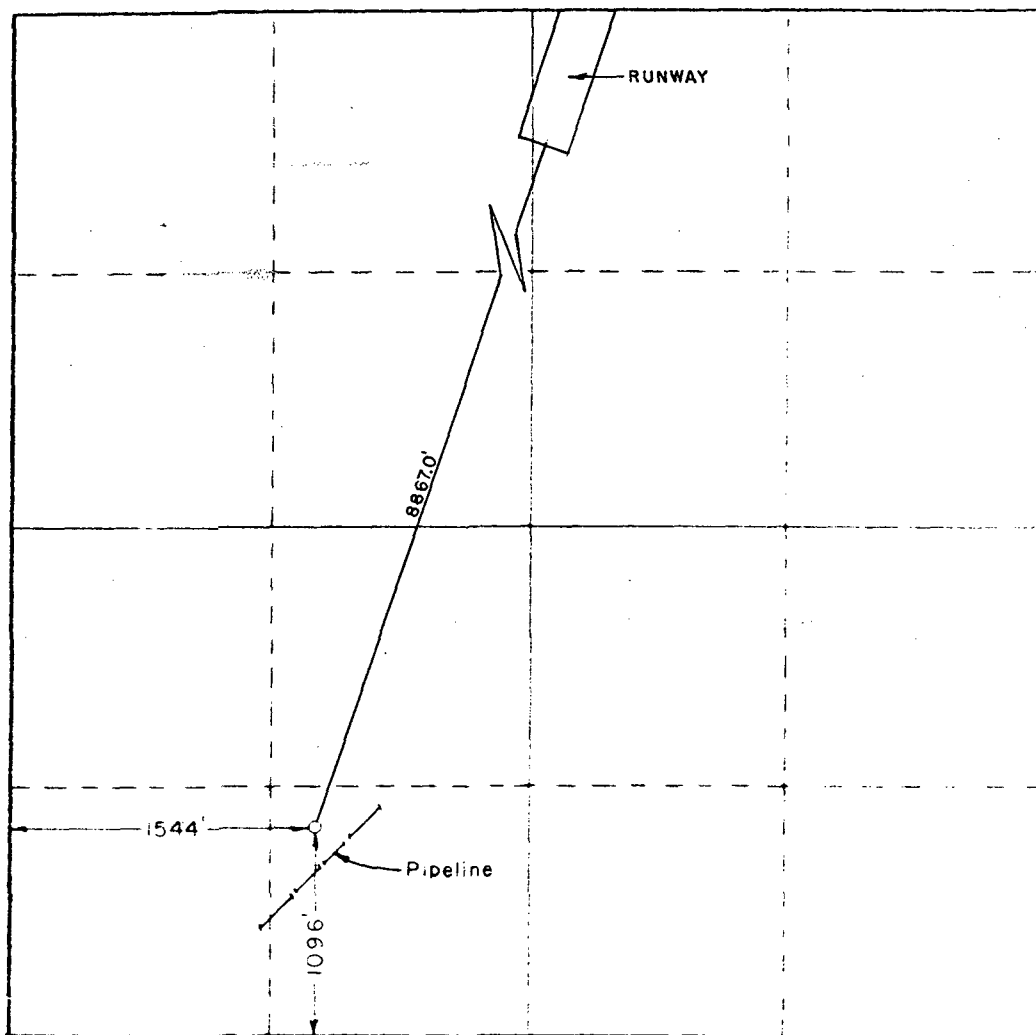

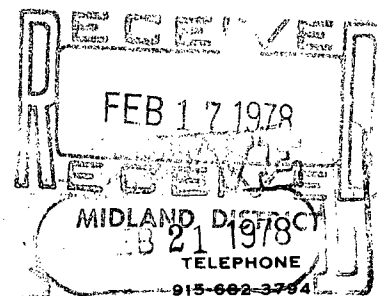

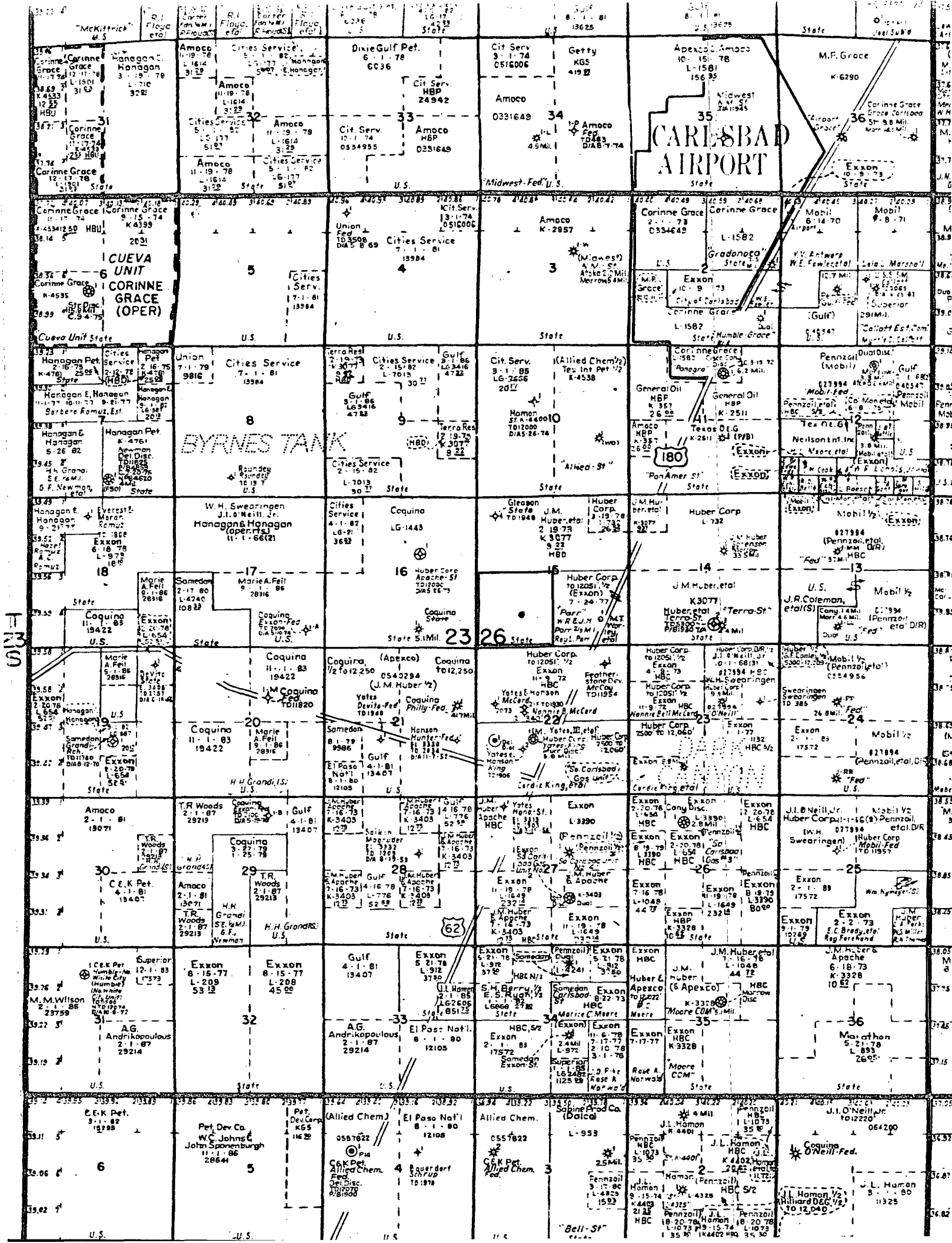
