Dear Mr. Ramey:

This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Blanco Mesa Verde pool.

It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company San Juan 28-6 Unit #55A at 1180' from the South line and 2220' from the East line of Section 9, T-28-N, R-6-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

A canyon with steeply sloping sides covers the southeast corner of this section, making it impossible to build an orthodox gas well location.

All operators of proration units offsetting the proposed unorthodox location have been notified of this application by certified mail.

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company has requested administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Blanco Mesa Verde pool.

It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company San Juan 28-6 Unit #55A at 1130' from the South line and 2220' from the East line of Section 9, T-28-N, R-6-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

A canyon with steeply sloping sides covers the southeast corner of this section making it impossible to build an orthodox gas well location.

In compliance with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission rules, we are notifying you, as operator of an offsetting proration unit, of our application for administrative approval for the aforementioned unorthodox gas well location.
