Flaherty, Environmental Scientist, USGS, Artesia, New Mexico.


A lease ownership map of the area of the proposed wellsite is en-

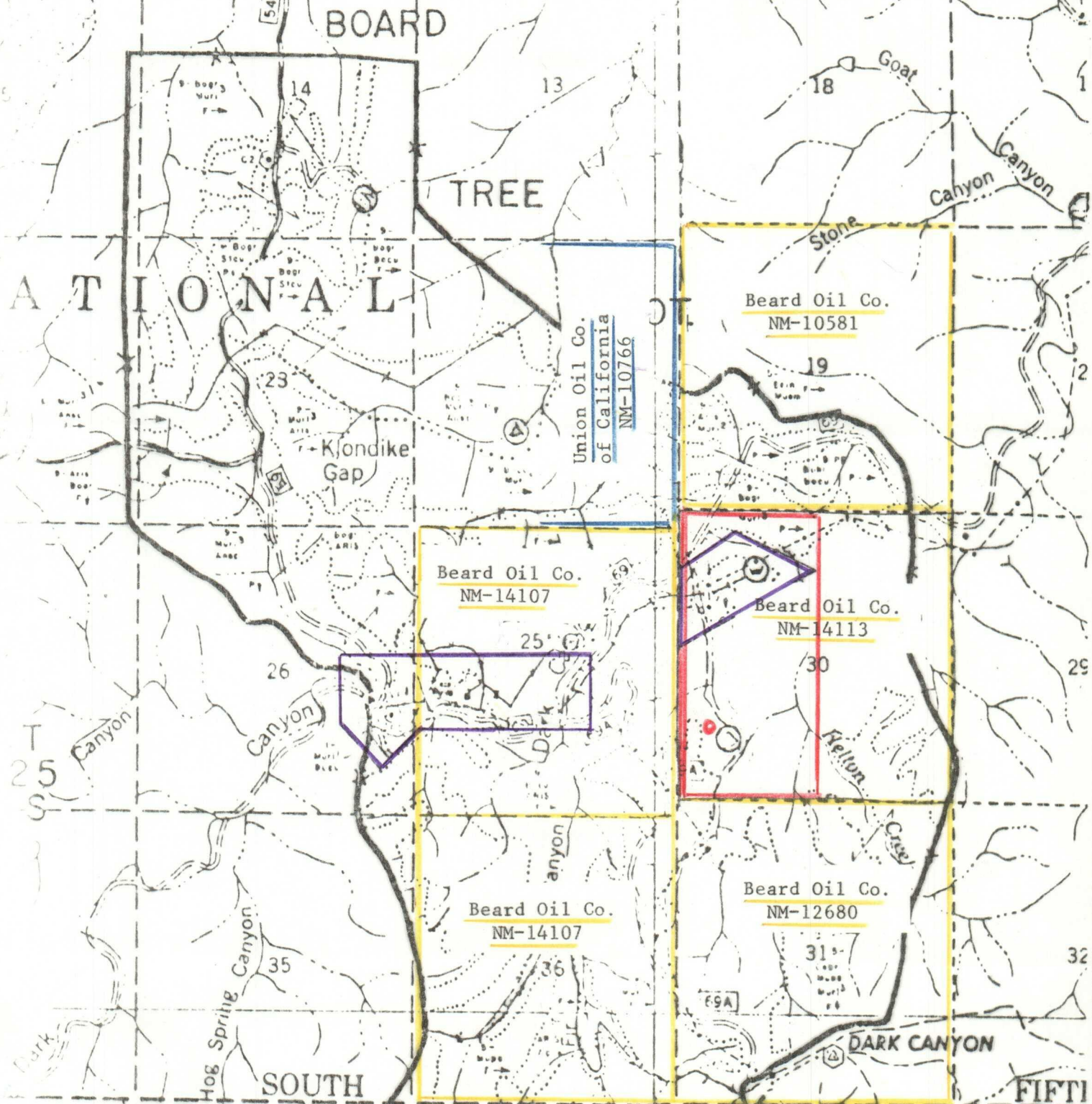

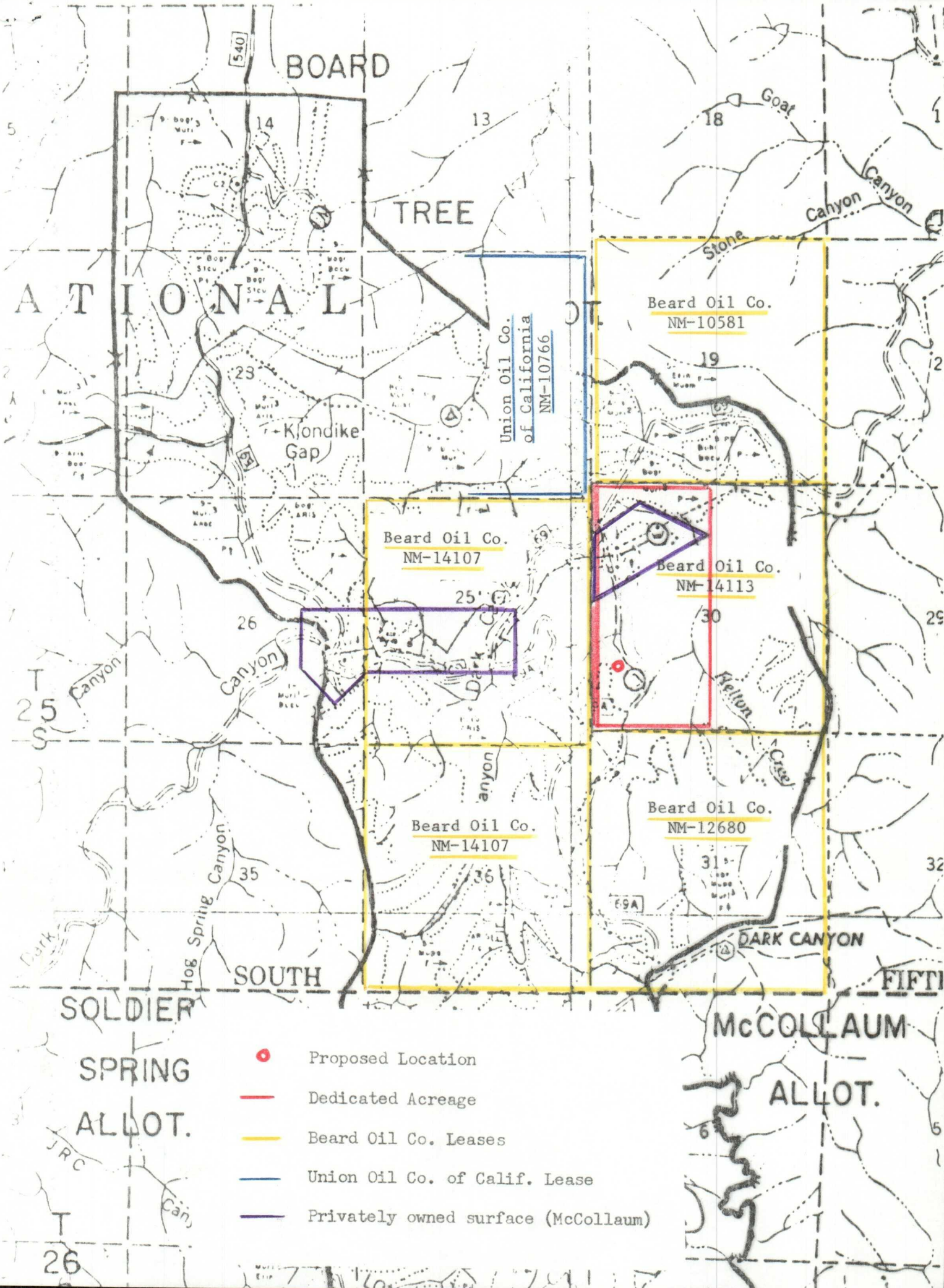
