Dear Mr. Ramey:

We are hereby requesting administrative approval for an unorthodox location in the Blanco Mesa Verde Field. This is an in-fill well which has been drilled at a location 655' FWL and 700' FNL of Section 10, T30N, R11W, San Juan County, New Mexico and this unorthodox location falls within the corporate limits of the city of Aztec, New Mexico and was necessary for safety reasons because of the many houses in the area.

There is no Mesa Verde producer in Sections 4, 9, or the S/2 of Section 10, or the S/2 of Section 3, T30N, R11W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

El Paso Natural Gas Company has a Mesa Verde producer located in Unit L of Section 11 to which the W/2 of Section 11 is dedicated and Tenneco has a Mesa Verde producer located in Unit K of Section 2 which is a W/2 Mesa Verde dedication.

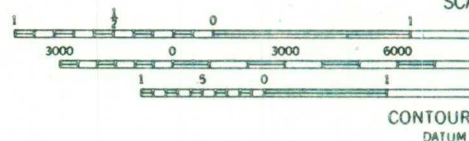

We are hereby requesting administrative approval for an unorthodox location in the Blanco Mesa Verde Field. This is an in-fill well which has been drilled at a location 655' FWL and 700' FNL of Section 10, T30N, R11W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

This location falls within the corporate limits of the city of Aztec, New Mexico and this location was the furthest removed from any houses or dwellings in the area.

There is no Mesa Verde producer in Sections 4, 9, or the S/2 of Section 10, or the S/2 of Section 3. T30N, R11W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The acreage in the S/2 of Section 3, SE/4 of Section 4 and most of Section 9 is owned by W. P. Carr. The balance of Section 9 and the west part of the SW/4 of Section 10 is town lots and small tracts within the Aztec city limits and is unleased.

El Paso Natural Gas Company has a Mesa Verde producer located in Unit L of Section 11 to which the W/2 of Section 11 is dedicated.

Tenneco has a Mesa Verde producer located in Unit K of Section 2 which is a W/2 Mesa Verde dedication.

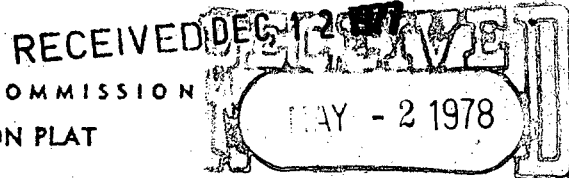

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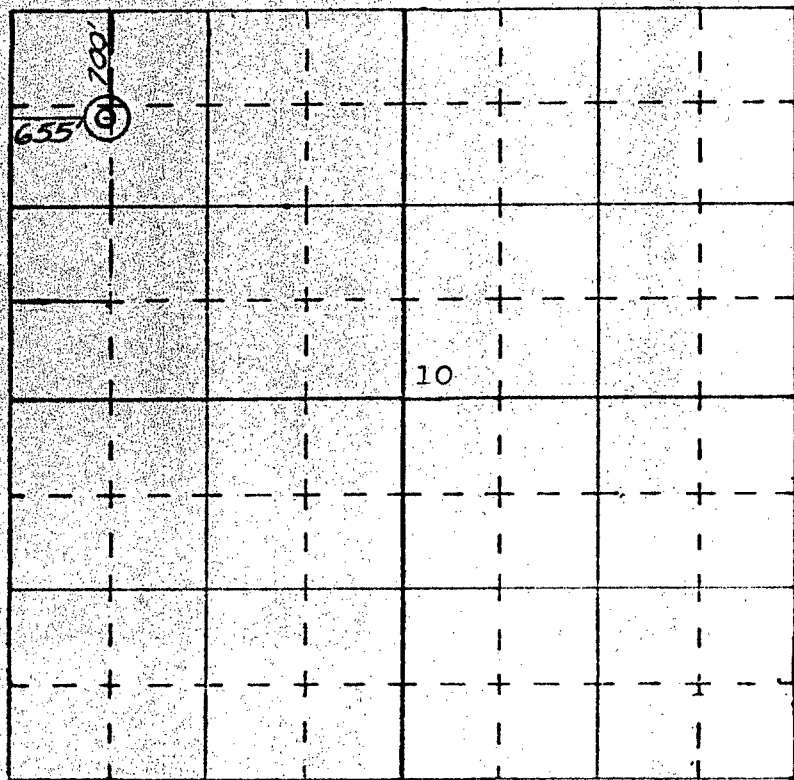

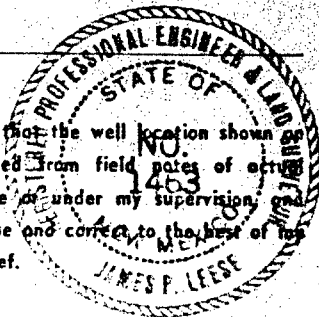
