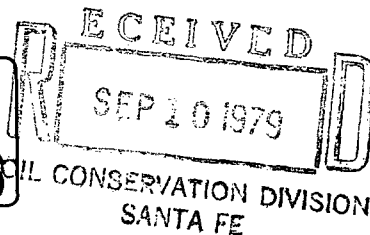

Gentlemen:

Cities Service Company, as operator of the Southeast Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Unit, a secondary recovery project, requestfully requests administrative approval, as authorized by Case No. 4750, Order No. R-3134-A, to drill Tract #5, Well #7, located 2615' from the North line and 2615' from the East line of Section 29, Township 17S, Range 33E, Lea County, New Mexico. The estimated total depth is 4380', the proposed perforations are between 4180', & 4330'. and the proposed casing program is shown below:

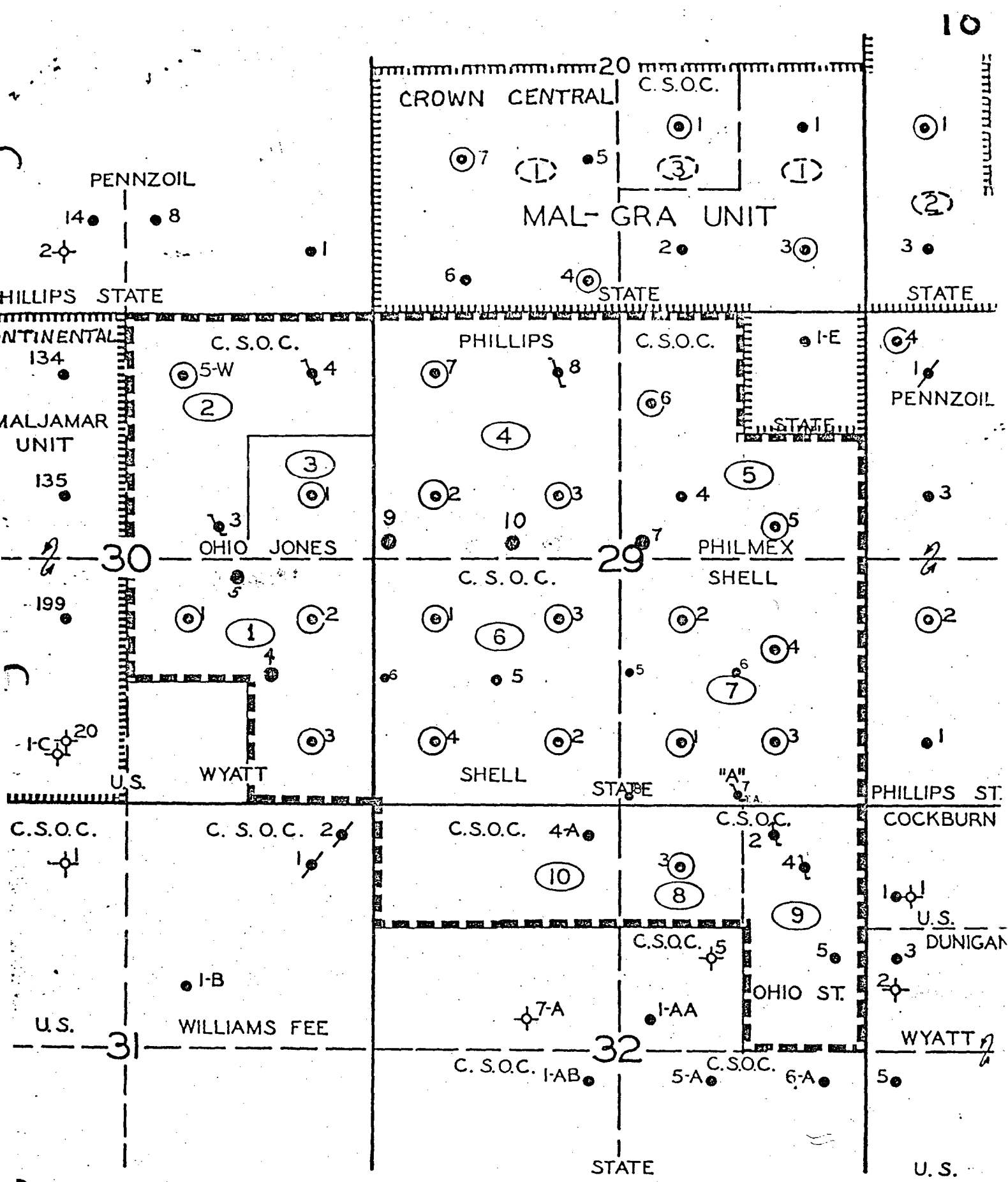
