Application is hereby made for administrative approval of an unorthodox location under Rule 104-F due to existent topographical conditions for Mesa Petroleum Co.'s Williamson Federal Com #2 to be located 2130 feet from the South line and 1800 feet from the West line of Section 12, Township 16 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, a developmental well to test the Atoka-Morrow formations.

Attached, please find a C-102 designating the acreage and location of the proposed well, a topographic map showing why the topographic features prohibit an orthodox location, and a map of surrounding leases showing that there are no offset operators other than Mesa Petroleum Co. producing from adjacent leases. Notification was provided to the following lease holders: Husky Oil, Champlin, Gulf, and Samedan as attested by the enclosed registered mail receipts.

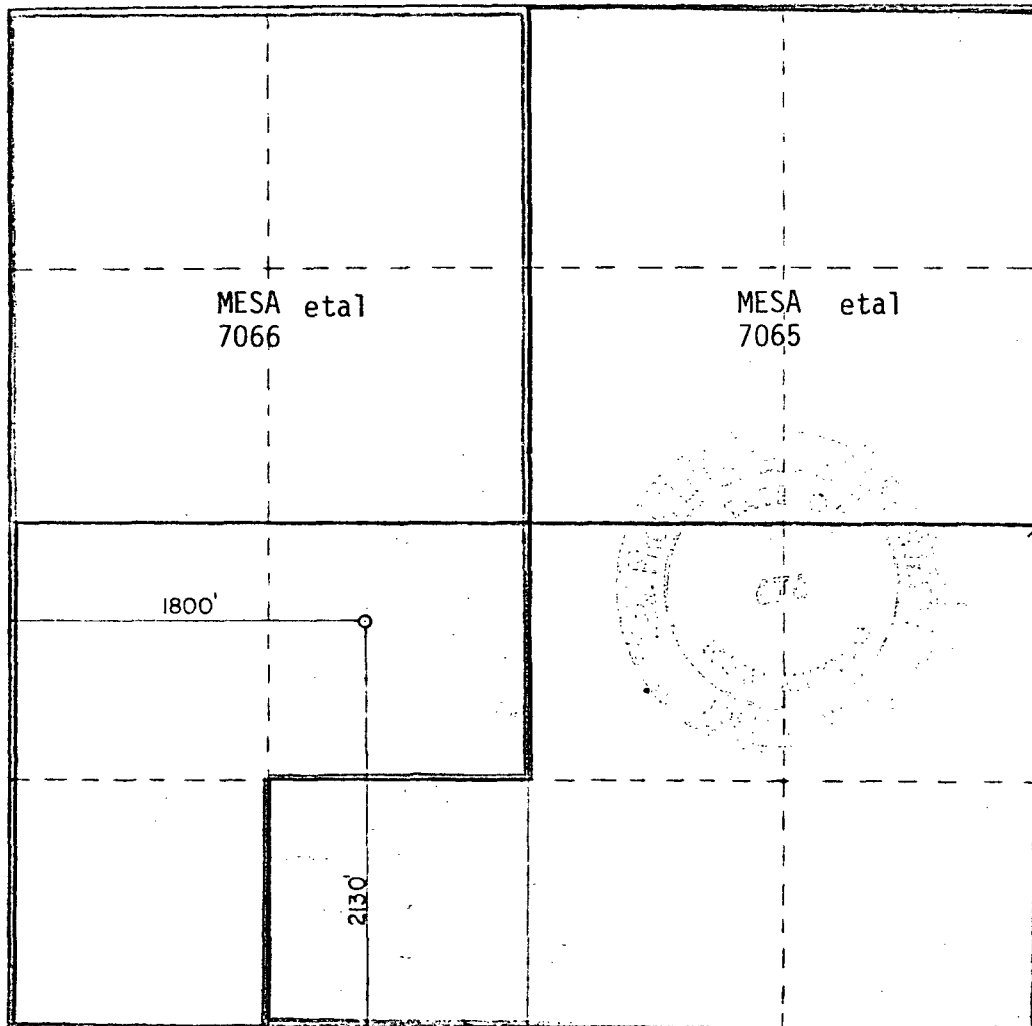
